

# Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2019  
Kumbia State School will receive

**\$29,056\***

## This funding will be used to

- Improve A-E results in English; Humanities, Arts and Social Science (HaSS); and Science which are reflective of students' reading ability i.e. **90%** of all Kumbia learners at a C level or above and 50% of these students at a B level or above.
- NAPLAN
  - 100% of students at or above National Minimum Standards (NMS) in Yr 3 and 5 reading;
  - 30% of students achieve Upper two bands (U2B) in reading;
  - 90% of all students meet regional benchmark for reading by the end of 2019.

## Our initiatives include

- Interrogation of Curriculum into the Classroom (C2C) units for the literacy demands and co-planning with a Curriculum Coach.
- Daily reading and writing opportunities embedded into the curriculum.
- Differentiation of learning so all students access curriculum based on the model of inclusion.

*Our work is modelled on the evidenced based research , "Putting Faces on Data' and 'Clarity' by Lyn Sharratt.*

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

1.	Engaging teacher aides to support students at risk and more able learners access the curriculum and enable them to communicate what they know and can do.	\$22,057

Providing up to 2 days per term for teacher release time to allow teachers to; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Collect and analyse literacy data eg reading and writing data and record progress on the literacy Continuum.</li> <li>• Engage with Regional expertise to interrogate achievement standards, curriculum intent and assessment tasks for the literacy demands of English, HaSS and Science.</li> <li>• Differentiate the literacy demands of English, HaSS and Science for students at risk and more able students.</li> </ul>	\$ 6,999
