## This funding will be used to


- Support student learning in reading so that 95% of students are at or above the National Minimum Standard in Year 3.
- Support student learning in reading so that 95% of students are at or above the National Minimum Standard in Year 5.
- Support student learning in reading so that 35% of students are within the Upper Two Bands in Year 3 reading.
- Support student learning in reading so that 40% of students are within the Upper Two Bands in Year 5 reading.
- Support all students across the school to ensure at least 12 months growth for every student in reading.
- Continue to implement or develop a learning plan for students who are at risk of achieving below the National Minimum Standard in all year levels. Plans are linked to the Kumbia State School Assessment and Benchmark tool and include short cycle data analysis. These plans will be linked directly to the continued placement of students in targeted intervention programs.

## Our initiatives include

- Building the capacity of teachers working in teaching teams to target students' individual learning needs in reading - Reading to Learn.
- Investing in teacher aide support for differentiated reading groups through the school.
- Provide professional development and coaching focused on teaching reading skills.
- Continuing to monitor targeted student performance regularly to diagnose learning needs and administer intervention strategies.
