Our school initiatives are on track to meet or exceed our targets

During 2018, we focused on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students. After reviewing our 2018 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we are on track to meet or exceed our targeted student outcomes. We continue to implement our initiatives to ensure that every student succeeds.

Initiatives implemented include:

Initiative 1: Investing in teacher aide support for differentiated reading groups through the school.

- All students are placed into reading groups based on need with Teaching of Reading programmes delivered to students using a shared and modelled approach.

Initiative 2: Provide professional development and coaching focused on teaching reading skills.

- All classroom teachers have had professional development by attending a Deslea Konza: Big 6 workshop.
- All teachers have worked with regional curriculum experts to explicitly plan for differentiation of reading and reading within the curriculum.
- All teacher aides have had the opportunity to work with our Learning Support Teacher to strengthen teaching practices through observation and feedback cycle.

Initiatives implemented include:

Initiative 3: Building the capacity of teachers working in teaching teams to target students' individual learning needs in reading

Initiative 4: Continuing to monitor targeted student performance regularly to diagnose learning needs and administer intervention strategies.

- Through a Case Management process, individual students have been selected for additional support in reading and their progress monitored.
